

And against the charter of Charles II. you will find that also for the plaintiff.

Gentlemen, you will be so good to signify to me, what your opinion is, with respect to the acceptance of the charter of Charles II. and then the officer shall take down your verdict upon the other issues, conformably to that leading idea.

*The jury withdrew about twenty minutes. When they returned into court, the foreman said,—“ My Lord, we find the “ charter of Charles the Second to be bad.”*

Verdict for the prosecutor, on the 3d, 5th, 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th issues.——Verdict for the defendant, on the remainder,—1st, 2d, 4th, 6th, 7th, and 8th.

N. B. The like verdict was entered, by consent, in the cause of the King against Mr. John Monk.
